

What is The Chartwell Cancer Trust Lily Pad Appeal?

The Chartwell Cancer Trust has teamed up with Croydon Health Services NHS to raise £750,000 to build a new and modernised Oncology Unit, a crucial part of the planned £3m overhaul to integrate Acute Paediatric Services in Croydon University Hospital.

Why are we raising funds?

Children's Emergency and Cancer Care services at Croydon University Hospital care for over 30,000 of our children each year with all kinds of health conditions. Children using these services currently receive exceptional care, sometimes in areas that haven't been fully refurbished for 30 years.

The new integrated paediatric unit, specifically designed to meet the needs of children and their families, will provide an improved environment, accommodating state of the art technology that will help to deliver high-quality treatment in modern surroundings and meet the future demands of children's healthcare.

A key area of the Paediatric refurbishment will be the new Cancer Unit which will help more children and young people with the life-changing illness. This dedicated ward will offer treatment for various types of cancer, with committed paediatric specialists working alongside other health professionals to offer the best care available.

The unit will transform the patient experience for children, young people and their families who are dealing with cancer and the possibility of spending up to two years in treatment for their illness.

- Specialist therapy facilities such as therapeutic play areas.
- A vibrant and uplifting environment.
- Improved equipment and storage facilities.
